## NOTES TO EXHIBITORS

A Recording Fee of \$0.50 and an Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club show or Obedience Trial. These fees are to be collected by the show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one regular or non-regular recordable single entry class in the show, a \$3.00 service fee is required for each additional entry. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2.)

### NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES.

TELEPHONE, TELEGRAPH, DIRECT FAX AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED. Any class changes or cancellations must be received in writing prior to the closing. Refund will be made after the show. Entries not on official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side of the official AKC Entry Forms are not acceptable. Please notify Secretary if Acknowledgment is not received by one week prior to the show.

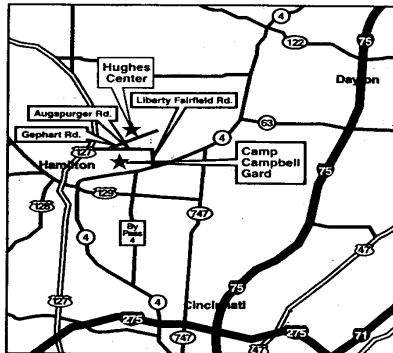

## DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

**From the North on Interstate 75:** South to the Route 63 (Exit 29). Go west on Rt. 63 to Rt. 4. Go South on Rt. 4 to Liberty-Fairfield Rd. Turn right on Liberty-Fairfield (stoplight and a Shell Station at the intersection) Cross over the river & turn left onto Augspurger Road. Just before the railroad tracks, turn right onto Gephart Road. Go up the hill, the show site is on the left.

**From the South on I-75 and either direction on I-71:** Take I-275 West. Exit at the Hamilton-Fairfield ramp, (Route 4). Turn right to ByPass Rt. 4. Stay on it until it reaches Route 4 again at traffic light (see map). Turn right onto Route 4. Turn left at Liberty-Fairfield (stoplight and a Shell Station at the intersection). Cross over river.
