WC Test:

- 1) Back to back singles in water to prove willingness to re-enter the water.
- 2) A land single retrieve of 50 yards in light cover.
- 3) The dog is not required to be steady or deliver to hand. The judge may designate an area for delivery.
- 4) The dog should not be gun shy.

Ducks will be used for water retrieves. Chukars will be used for land retrieves.

Times:

Water retrieving tests will be run beginning at 11:00 AM on Thursday, May 13, 2010. Please arrive early for judge's instructions. Only dogs who pass the water test will be permitted to run the land retrieves. If number of entries and time allows, land retrieving tests will be run immediately following completion of water tests. If time does not allow land tests to be run on Thursday, land retrieving tests will begin approximately ½ hour after completion of judging in the conformation ring on Friday, May 14, 2010. (Approximately 3:00 p.m.)

Entry Fees:

Entry fees are \$25, payable in US funds. Entries are limited to 45 dogs. Entries must be received by the WC Secretary by Wednesday, April 21, 2010

Miscellaneous:

Entered dogs must be AKC registered.

All dogs qualifying for the LRC, Inc. Working Certificate will receive a qualifying ribbon and an application for an official LRC, Inc. Working Certificate. And a Purina Pro Plan Slip Lead offered by Purina

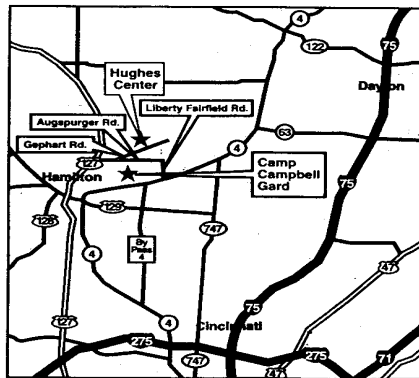
DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE


From the North on Interstate 75:

South to the Route 63 (Exit 29). Go west on Rt. 63 to Rt. 4. Go South on Rt. 4 to Liberty-Fairfield Rd. Turn right on Liberty-Fairfield (stoplight and a Shell Station at the intersection) Cross over the river & turn left onto Augspurger Road. Just before the railroad tracks, turn right onto Gephart Road. Go up the hill, the show site is on the left.

From the South on I-75 and either direction on I-71:

Take I-275 West. Exit at the Hamilton-Fairfield ramp, (Route 4). Turn right to ByPass Rt. 4. Stay on it until it reaches Route 4 again at traffic light (see map). Turn right onto Route 4. Turn left at Liberty-Fairfield (stoplight and a Shell Station at the intersection). Cross over river. Turn left onto Augspurger Road. Just before the railroad tracks turn right onto Gephart Road. Go up the hill, the show site is on the left.
